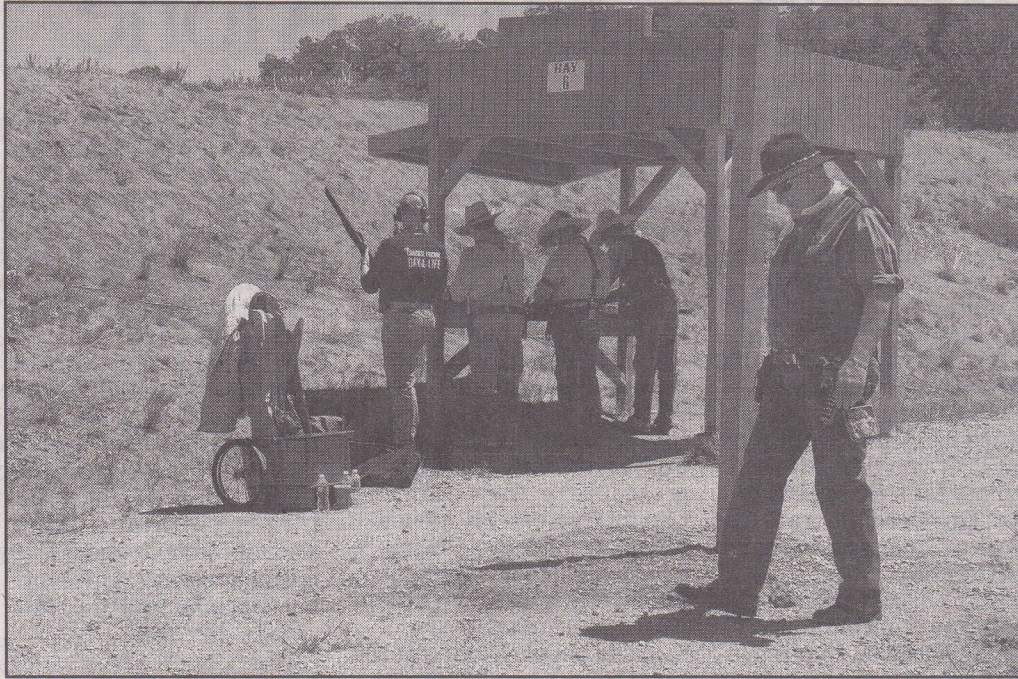


READY, AIM, FIRE
